

## Transfer Success Action Plan Until you have completed 30 transferable semester units (Freshman)

Complete transferable English and Math courses as early as possible as well as the <u>UC Seven Course Pattern</u> and
the <u>CSU Golden Four</u> required to meet minimum eligibility requirements.

If you already know your major and the universities you want to transfer to, start taking your major preparation

Complete a variety of transferable exploratory courses in your area(s) of interest from IGETC and/or CSU GE.
Declare your college major no later than the end of your second semester.
Select at least 3 universities to which you will apply. Use the resources on the Transfer Center's Explore and

Attend annual Transfer Day in November to meet with university representatives
Participate in Virtual College Fairs through CollegeWeek Live and PrepTalk.
Meet with <u>University Admissions Representatives</u> in the Transfer Center.
Attend workshops sponsored by the Transfer Center, Career Center, and the Learning Resource Center (LRC).
Participate in student clubs and organizations that match your interests.
Volunteer or do an internship.
Find out about Summer Programs related to your major (area of interest) offered by four-year universities and
apply.
Check your academic progress by using MAP
Meet with a counselor to update your Academic Plan.
